



## **Year 6 - Summer Term 2018 Topic Sheet**

### **Maths**

All topics will be revised and consolidated throughout the term, according to the children's needs in preparation for their SATs in May. There will be a particular emphasis on using and applying the children's mathematical knowledge and understanding through a variety of contexts. We will also be concentrating on the children's understanding of word problems and using investigations to stretch their experience and knowledge.

### **English**

The children will be learning about play scripts both Shakespeare's writing and performing, with a particular focus on Macbeth.

In preparation for the spelling, punctuation and grammar test and the teacher assessment of writing, we will be focusing on the children's understanding and correct use of English Grammar.

After the SATs we will explore and continue to compare themes and characters across our previous texts and continue to develop our writing skills in preparation for year 7.

### **Science**

We will be undertaking a unit on living things. Children will be learning how to classify animals and plants. The second unit of study is around evolution and inheritance.

### **PE**

*Games:* Cricket & Athletics – this will involve the development of skills, the rules of the games and the equipment used. The children will have many opportunities to consolidate their understanding of team work and its importance within a game environment. This will be in preparation for sports day.

*Dance:* will be working towards our summer dance afternoon presentations.

*Gym:* Children will be developing their agility, balance and co-ordination skills in a wide range of modified games.

### **PSHE**

Our studies will be based on Emotional Health – including preparing for high school, managing conflict and coping with anger.

### **Art**

Greek poetry: linked to history, children will design and make a Greek vase.

### **Humanities**

A study of life in Ancient Greece – covering the lands of Ancient Greece, lifestyle, schooling, architecture and food. As well as developing their mapping skills.

### **ICT**

Controls and monitoring- Children will learn to code to control a program.

### **RE**

This term's studies will be based around the faith of Christianity.

### **Music**

This term the children will be learning about how composers work

### **MFL**

Children will be learning how to talk about school and family in Spanish.
